The Dog Control Orders (Prescribed Offences and Penalties, etc) Regulations 2006 (S.I.2006/1059)

The Dogs on Leads (Blackburn with Darwen) Order 2013

Blackburn with Darwen Borough Council hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order comes into force on the 1st April 2013
- 2. This Order applies to the land specified in Schedules attached

Offence

- 3. (1) A person in charge of a dog shall be guilty of an offence if, at any time, on any land to which this Order applies he/she does not keep the dog on a lead, unless
 - (a) He has a reasonable excuse to do so; or
 - (b) The owner, occupier or other person or authority having control of the land has consented (generally or specifically) to his failing to do so
 - (2) For the purpose of this article
 - (a) a person who habitually has a dog in his possession shall be taken to be in charge of the dog at any time unless at that time some other person is in charge of the dog.

Penalty

4. A person who is guilty of an offence under article 3 shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
